The Series 670 and 770 sliding glass doors will be available to order at the end of 2009. The products will be available in a variety of finishes: clear anodize, Arizona beige, Pebble Khaki, Venetian Bronze and ETERNA® Finish. White and bronze are standard frame finish options.

Additional features of the Series 670 and 770 sliding glass doors include: dual point mortise locking mechanism; choice of raised handles or recessed pulls; roller assembly options: 2 1/8" wheels as either tandem steel wheels, tandem stainless steel wheels or tandem Delrin® wheels with stainless steel housing; replaceable sill tracks; and design pressures of +/- 60 up to +90/-110.

In August 2009, Class II clear anodize frame finish option will be available to order. This classic aluminum finish will be available with WinGuard and Architectural Systems products.
